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

- I Life today is becoming very busy. We don't always have time to pay attention to elderly people. As a result, many elderly people feel lonely. In the Netherlands, for example, 50% of elderly people say they are lonely. Jumbo, a large supermarket chain¹ with more than 700 stores, wanted to help.
- II Jumbo made a special "slow lane²" for their elderly customers in the supermarkets. Tess Mulder, one of Jumbo's managers, explains, "In a regular lane, people buy their food quickly. But in the slow lane, elderly customers can stop and talk with the supermarket workers. They can talk about their lives, their grandchildren, or anything else. This helps them feel less lonely."



III Jumbo's slow lanes were a big success, and other people also wanted to use the slow lanes. So, the supermarket chain decided to let anyone enjoy their slow lanes – not just elderly people. Recently, Jumbo had another idea: They asked volunteers to come to the supermarket to have coffee with the customers and talk with them. Jumbo is doing a lot to help the elderly and any other people who might feel lonely.


